SAINT PATRICK WAS ACTUALLY BRITISH

ALTHOUGH HE'S ONE OF IRELAND'S MOST CELEBRATED FIGURES, PATRICK WAS BORN AROUND THE YEAR 390 IN WHAT IS NOW ENGLAND, SCOTLAND OR WALES.

HIS REAL NAME WAS MAEWIN SUCCAT.

MAEWIN SUCCAT WAS HIS NAME UNTIL HE CHANGED IT TO PATRICK WHEN HE BECAME A BISHOP.

MARCH 17 IS NOT SAINT PATRICK'S BIRTHDAY

ST. PATRICK'S DAY OBSERVERS WHO MIGHT HAVE THOUGHT THEY WERE CELEBRATING THE SAINT'S BIRTHDAY WILL BE SURPRISED TO LEARN THAT MARCH 17, 461 AD IS ACTUALLY THE DAY HE DIED.

THE FIRST ST. PATRICK'S DAY PARADE HAPPENED IN AMERICA, NOT IRELAND

WITH AN INCREASE OF IRISH IMMIGRANTS ENTERING THE UNITED STATES, ST. PATRICK'S DAY QUICKLY BECAME A WIDESPREAD HOLIDAY.

ST. PATRICK HAD NO SNAKES TO BANISH

LEGEND SAYS THAT ST. PATRICK DROVE IRELAND'S SNAKES INTO THE SEA, PURGING THE LAND OF ALL "EVIL." HOWEVER, RESEARCH CONTRADICTS THIS TALE, INDICATING THAT SNAKES NEVER INHABITED THE EMERALD ISLE

— AS THE ENTIRE ISLAND WAS ONCE COVERED IN ICE, AND THERE IS NO FOSSIL EVIDENCE OF SNAKES IN THE REGION.

IT USED TO BE A DRY HOLIDAY

ST. PATRICK'S DAY WAS CONSIDERED A RELIGIOUS HOLIDAY IN IRELAND FOR MOST OF THE 20TH CENTURY, SO ALL PUBS WOULD CLOSE ON MARCH 17TH.

EVERYONE SHOULD BE WEARING BLUE, NOT GREEN

BLUE WAS ACTUALLY THE COLOR THAT WAS MOST ASSOCIATED WITH PATRICK AND GREEN WAS CONSIDERED UNLUCKY. BLUE IS STILL CONSIDERED SYMBOLIC OF IRELAND.

CORNERED BEEF AND CABBAGE IS AN AMERICAN INVENTION

THE CLASSIC ST. PATRICK'S DAY DISH — MADE WITH CHOPPED MEAT, POTATOES AND FRIED ONIONS — DIDN'T ORIGINATE IN IRELAND AT ALL. WHILE HAM AND CABBAGE WERE TRADITIONAL IRISH FARE, CORNERED BEEF BECAME A MORE AFFORDABLE ALTERNATIVE FOR IRISH AMERICANS.

DESPITE ITS NAME, THERE'S NO CORN IN CORNERED BEEF. THE TERM "CORNERED" ACTUALLY REFERS TO THE SIZABLE GRAINS OF SALT HISTORICALLY USED TO CURE MEATS, KNOWN AS "CORNS."

HAIRY FACTS



- * THE AVERAGE HUMAN HEAD HAS 100,000 HAIR FOLLICLES. EACH OF THOSE FOLLICLES IS CAPABLE OF PRODUCING 20 INDIVIDUAL HAIRS DURING A PERSON'S LIFETIME.
- * HAIR COLOR HELPS DETERMINE HOW DENSE THE HAIR ON YOUR HEAD IS. BLONDES (ONLY NATURAL ONES, OF COURSE) HAVE THE DENSEST HAIR, AVERAGING 146,000 FOLLICLES. PEOPLE WITH BLACK HAIR TEND TO HAVE ABOUT 110,000 FOLLICLES. THOSE WITH BROWN HAIR ARE ABOUT AVERAGE WITH 100,000 FOLLICLES. REDHEADS HAVE THE LEAST DENSE HAIR, AVERAGING ABOUT 86,090 FOLLICLES.
- * NEARLY 80 PERCENT OF PEOPLE IN THE UNITED STATES SAY THEY SPEND MORE MONEY ON HAIR PRODUCTS THAN ANY OTHER GROOMING GOODS.
- * DESPITE ALL THE EFFORT WE PUT INTO COIFING AND PAMPERING OUR LOCKS, THE HAIR WE SEE IS BIOLOGICALLY DEAD. HAIR IS ALIVE ONLY IN THE ROOTS, WHICH ARE FED BY SMALL BLOOD VESSELS BENEATH THE SKIN'S SURFACE.
- * HAIR CELLS TRAVEL UP THE SHAFT AND ARE EVENTUALLY CUT OFF FROM THE BLOOD SUPPLY THAT IS THEIR NOURISHMENT. THE CELLS DIE BEFORE BEING PUSHED OUT OF THE FOLLICLE ONTO THE HEAD—OR BACK, ARM, OR ANYWHERE ELSE.
- * HAIR IS INCREDIBLY STRONG. THE AVERAGE HEAD OF HAIR CAN SUPPORT ROUGHLY 12 TONS OF WEIGHT—MUCH MORE THAN THE SCALP IT'S ATTACHED TO.
- * HAIR GROWS IN CYCLES. DURING THE FIRST PHASE, HAIR IS ACTIVELY GROWING. IN THE SECOND PHASE, IT RESTS IN THE FOLLICLE UNTIL IT IS PUSHED OUT OF THE ROOT.
- * HEALTHY HAIR GROWS ABOUT 0.39 INCH IN A MONTH.
- * EACH HAIR IS COMPLETELY INDEPENDENT FROM THE OTHERS.
- * WHEN A HAIR FALLS OUT, ANOTHER ONE MAY NOT GROW DIRECTLY IN ITS PLACE.
- * THE AVERAGE PERSON LOSES BETWEEN 50 AND 100 RESTING HAIRS EACH DAY.
- * WE ARE BORN WITH EVERY HAIR FOLLICLE WE'LL EVER HAVE, THOUGH THE COMPOSITION, COLOR, AND PATTERN OF THE HAIR CHANGES OVER TIME.
- * HAIR IS MADE OF PROTEIN.
- * EATING A HEALTHY DIET THAT CONTAINS SUFFICIENT PROTEIN, VITAMINS, MINERALS, AND WATER IS THE BEST WAY TO ENSURE HEALTHY HAIR.

LEPRECHAUNS ARE SAID TO HAVE MAGICAL POWERS, INCLUDING THE ABILITY TO CRAFT ITEMS, USE CURSE MAGIC, AND GRANT LUCK

OCCUPATION

LEPRECHAUNS ARE OFTEN DEPICTED AS SHOEMAKERS, HAMMERING AWAY AT THEIR CRAFT IN REMOTE LOCATIONS

TREASURE

LEPRECHAUNS ARE OFTEN ASSOCIATED WITH HIDDEN POTS OF GOLD AT THE END OF THE RAINBOW

ST. PATRICK'S DAY

LEPRECHAUNS ARE COMMONLY ASSOCIATED WITH ST. PATRICK'S DAY

POPULAR CULTURE

LEPRECHAUNS HAVE BEEN FEATURED IN MANY WORKS OF POPULAR CULTURE, INCLUDING AS THE MASCOT FOR NOTRE DAME'S FIGHTING IRISH AND THE LUCKY CHARMS CEREAL.

PEANUT BUTTER POTATO CANDY

THIS SIMPLE PEANUT BUTTER POTATO CANDY IS AN OLD FASHIONED IRISH TREAT MADE WITH ONLY 3 INGREDIENTS, IT'S GLUTEN-FREE AND DOESN'T REQUIRE ANY BAKING!



PREP TIME: 30 MIN
CHILLING TIME: 1 HR

INGREDIENTS:

- 1 SMALL RUSSET POTATO
- 3-4 CUPS POWDERED SUGAR
- 1/3 CUPS PEANUT BUTTER

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. IN A SMALL POT OF BOILING WATER, COOK THE POTATO UNTIL TENDER. DRAIN AND TRANSFER TO A BOWL; MASH UNTIL SMOOTH AND LUMP-FREE. LET COOL COMPLETELY.
2. WITH AN ELECTRIC MIXER ON LOW SPEED, BEAT TOGETHER THE POTATO AND POWDERED SUGAR, ONE CUP AT A TIME, UNTIL MIXTURE IS THICK AND THE PEARLY DOUGH FORMS.
3. TRANSFER THE DOUGH ONTO A LARGE SHEET OF PARCHMENT PAPER SPRINKLED WITH POWDERED SUGAR; DUST MORE POWDERED SUGAR ON TOP. USING A ROLLING PIN, ROLL THE DOUGH INTO A LARGE RECTANGULAR SHAPE, APPROXIMATELY 1/4-INCH THICK; TRIM TO FORM STRAIGHT EDGES.
4. SPREAD PEANUT BUTTER OVER DOUGH. STARTING AT ONE LONG SIDE, TIGHTLY ROLL UP CANDY, JELLY-ROLL STYLE, USING PARCHMENT PAPER AS A GUIDE. WRAP IN PARCHMENT PAPER OR PLASTIC WRAP, AND FREEZE OR REFRIGERATE FOR 30-60 MINUTES.
5. UNWRAP AND CUT CANDY INTO 1/4-INCH THICK PIECES. ENJOY!
